PRP & Microneedling

PRP is placed back into the skin by injection or microneedling, it initiates a localised stem cell response. Over the weeks and months following treatment, this cellular response recruits collagen-producing cells called fibroblasts. The fibroblasts replace tissue that has been damaged or lost through the aging process with healthy skin that looks refreshed and rejuvenated.

What is the Cost of PRP?

It depends on the exact areas treated and amounts of PRP used.

PLATELET RICH PLASMA (PRP) HAIR

How does it work?

It stimulates the cells in your hair follicles which may lie dormant in your scalp. The growth factors released by the platelets stimulate improved blood supply and growth of new blood vessels on your scalp, which improves hair growth of dormant hair follicles. The hair also gets thicker, denser and stronger.

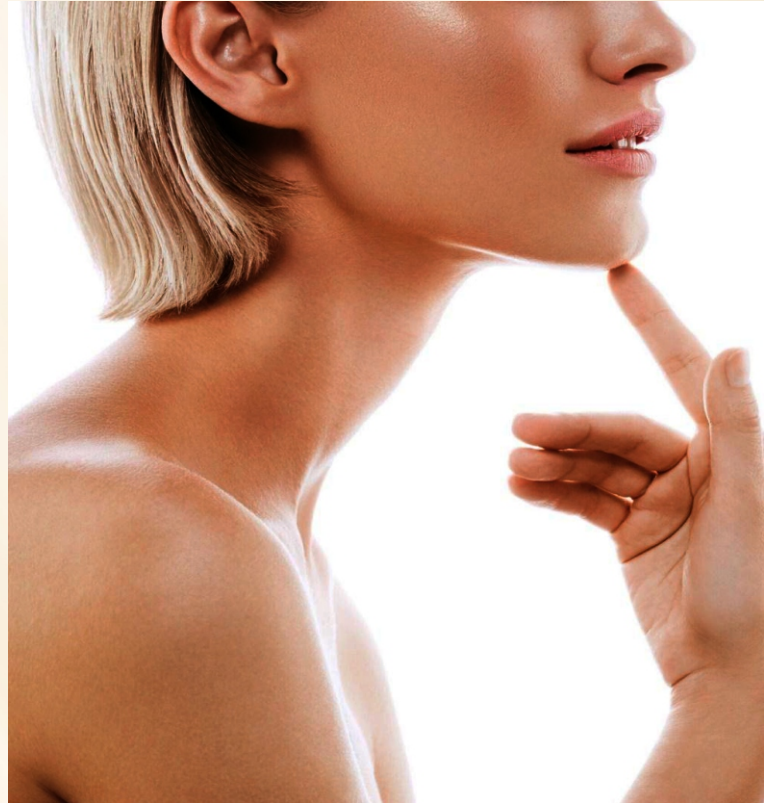
Studies show that PRP is even better than Minoxidil, one of the most widely used medications for hair loss therapy. When the hair follicles are not present anymore, you will need a hair transplant.

What is the Cost of PRP?

It depends on the exact areas treated and amounts of PRP used.

How many treatments does one need?

You will need 3-6 sessions 6 weeks apart to get optimal results.

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PRP – PLATELET RICH PLASMA SKIN & HAIR REJUVENATION

• Platelet-rich plasma also known as PRP refers to autologous plasma, the liquid part of your own blood containing concentrated number of platelets to get the purest form of platelets which play a central role in wound healing and tissue regeneration since they contain a vast number of growth factors. These are important to improve your skin, thicken the dermis thus reducing wrinkles or dark circles under the eye, or to help restore hair growth on your scalp.

WHAT IT IS USED FOR:

- Natural wrinkle treatment of face and neck
- Skin rejuvenation
- Skin texture improvement
- Softens dark circles under the eyes
- Supportive therapy after laser or microneedling
- Sun damaged skin – better hydration and elasticity
- Better hair growth (thicker, stronger, more vital)
- Androgenic alopecia or alopecia areata
- Improvement in wound healing (in combination with fat grafting), e.g diabetic foot ulcers
- Sports Medicine: therapy of muscle and tendon injuries
- Orthopaedics: therapy for arthritis and degeneration



PRP FOR SKIN REJUVENATION

- We take 5 – 10ml of your blood, this is then centrifuged and the plasma separated from the other blood cells. The yellow-clear plasma is transferred to small syringes and injected intradermally. The regeneration process is initiated by the release of growth factors within the plasma platelets.
- PRP stimulates the breakdown of sun-damaged structures in your skin, and stimulates collagen production to make the skin thicker and healthier. The elasticity improves, as well as better hydration, resulting in reduction of wrinkles. The skin texture is improved, you get an increase glow as well as some volume improvement



PRP IN COMBINATION WITH MICRONEEDLING

PRP in combination with micro needling:

PRP is ideal for combination with medical needling – numerous studies have shown that the PRP and needling leads to better results for skin rejuvenation and higher patient satisfaction compared to micro needling alone. KIM KARDASHIAN is famous for doing this therapy regularly to improve her skin glow (in the US they call it the VAMPIRE FACELIFT).

PRP supports a better outcome and quicker healing not only with microneedling, but also with ablative or fractionated laser rejuvenation of your face: the topical application of PRP following microneedling or laser therapy speeds up the recovery and improves healing of the skin.
